## **STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES**

Student fund-raising activities will be permitted, provided they are conducted either:

1. In conjunction with a PTO, PTSO, SSEPAC, FAME, or Boosters fund-raising activity or publication, or any other organization recognized as a school system support group by vote of the School Committee, or
2. In support of a school system sanctioned student athletic, civic, or scholarø program, or
3. In conjunction with a school sanctioned publication, or in the sale of tickets to a scheduled athletic, dramatic, or musical event.

Student groups must obtain permission in advance for each fund-raising event or activity from their faculty advisor and the buildingø Principal.

Guidelines for approval for all appropriate fund-raising activities will fall under the responsibility of the Superintendent or his/her designee.

All fund-raising activities will be accomplished during non-academic time periods. Any use of academic time for planning of a fund-raising activity must be approved in advance by the buildingø Principal.
